Redding Family Foundation History

Marshall E. Redding, MD, a former Granville County resident and prominent cardiovascular and thoracic surgeon in Long Beach, California, established the RFF as a tribute to his late parents. His father, Mr. James Romeo Redding, served as the county Agricultural Extension Agent for twenty-eight years and his mother, Mrs. Bessie Bizzelle Redding, was a highly respected educator.

The RFF has made scholarship awards for more than thirty years and has donated over \$300,000 to Granville County students that meet the RFF's selection criteria.

Our Mission

The Foundation supports the development of a more positive and healthy society in the United States by contributing to the cost of undergraduate education for students who possess the intellectual capabilities for academic success, are financially unable to fund the undergraduate experience, and have the desire and ability to make positive contributions to society. FAQs

What is this scholarship?

This scholarship is a financial award, provided to students who will attend a two or four-year college or university. The award is awarded to selected students who qualify in three basic areas:

- Scholarship and strong academic standing.
- Service to others and a willingness to give back to the community.
- Financial need.

Who is eligible to apply?

Any Granville County public, high school student that is a senior and scheduled to graduate in the current academic year may apply. Students receiving the scholarship may apply for renewal of the award each year of their undergraduate education, limited to three renewals.

How does a student complete the application?

Students should request a copy of the application from their guidance counselor. Fill out all parts of the application and attach any requested items. Students will need to have their parent/guardian assist them with the application, as some of the information is required from both. Once the application is complete, submit it to your guidance counselor.

What is the deadline for application?

The deadline to have the entire, complete application submitted with all supporting documentation is May 18, 2026.

How are students selected for the scholarship?

The Board of Directors of the RFF reviews the applications and will make the final decisions on recipients.

What is the dollar amount of the scholarship?

One thousand dollars per academic year (\$500 per semester)
